Pier Luigi De Angelis and Albert Scherger remain Managing Directors, the former for the ordinary management of the financial, administration, and control area, the latter for the ordinary management of industrial and commercial activities.

The Remuneration Committee (consisting of Mario d'Urso, Giuseppe Lignana and Alberto Pirelli) and the Audit Committee (consisting of Mario d'Urso, Marcello Gallo and Alberto Pecci) were also integrated.
